Update from the Ontario Chamber of Commerce Annual General Meeting

This past weekend, Cornwall, Ontario played host to 200 delegates from across the province at the OCC AGM.

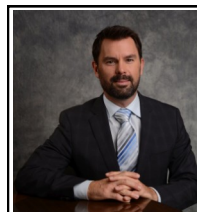
The uniqueness of this event was the location of the conference, the NAV Centre was also host to 500 displaced Cree First Nations people from the community of Kashechewan during the spring melt and we congratulate the NAV Centre for ensuring their safety.

Secondly, the OCC delegation had the opportunity to hear from and speak with a number of dignitaries including Premier Kathleen Wynne, Interim Leader of the PC Party of Ontario Jim Wilson and the Leader of Ontario's New Democrats Andrea Horwath.

Items of importance during the sessions, including the policy floor included: Addressing Ontario's Rising Electricity Costs, Addressing Ontario's Infrastructure Deficit, Carbon Pricing, Need for WSIB Reform, Reconsider Approach to Addressing Ontario's Retirement Savings, Reforming College of Trades, Implementation of a One Number Business, Using Private and Not-for-Profit Sectors to Deliver Public Services, Support for Travel Rebate Incentive Program, Support for Trans Canada's Energy East Project, Maintaining Ontario's Mining Tax Rates, to name just a few of the 41 resolutions put forward.
