City's Capital Project update for the week of October 26, 2015

Pinewood Park Sewer - Labelle flushed the pipe last week but did not have anyone available to video the pipe until this week. Pipe was videoed yesterday and noticed that they had not fully cleaned the pipe the first time due to a hardened silt in the bottom of the pipe and re-flushed it and will re-video once fully cleaned. They found only 3 leaks in the pipe at this time which they believe can be fixed by grout injection. JP said that MX's pipe appears to be in good condition with no leaks and does not appear deflected or out of round. Labelle is currently prepping for Miller Paving who will be paving this Thursday. They also need to bench that one manhole on Lakeshore Drive. By next week, Labelle should be completely demobilized from site.

John St Bridge - As mentioned earlier, the Contractor was set back as a result of encountering bedrock to east of the bridge where underground services needed to be upgraded. The bedrock is now removed and they have begun installing the sewer and water and backfilling the bridge. Once bridge is fully backfilled, Belanger will be able to construct the approach slabs and waterproof the deck. Demora (Belanger's sub) is finalizing their block retaining wall design in hopes to begin its installation in the next couple of days which is also required to completely backfill the west side of the bridge to allow the installation of the approach slab. Other remaining works include the removal of all the formwork required for the installation of the deck, installation of the curbs and sidewalks, road construction and paving. Contractor is hopeful everything will be completed within the next 4-6 weeks.

Ferguson (Phase 2 - Worthington to Fifth) - Contractor will complete upper and lower binder asphalt lifts at Worthington intersection and side streets. Top lift of asphalt will probably be completed next week, depending on weather. Some sidewalks will be completed this week as well.

(Phase 3 - Princess to Chippewa) - Contractor will complete curbs, except around the catchbasins. Granular A for road building will be started after the curb is in place. They may do Chippewa intersection - asphalt removal and curbs on east side. They may do asphalt base coat but that will depend on weather and sub-contractor availability.

Cedar Hts. Watermain project - The contractor is planning on finishing up with the commissioning and the connections of the new watermains to the existing. They will continue to build the roadway on College Dr. between the South and North entrances to the Education Complex. The contractor will start the installation of the pathway lighting poles. Paving crews have been scheduled to be on site most of the week to continue with the paving of the pathway from the South project limit at the hospital entrance to Monastery Rd. Intersection. Contractor will start to grade and topsoil the ditches between the South and North entrances to Canadore College and Nipissing University.
